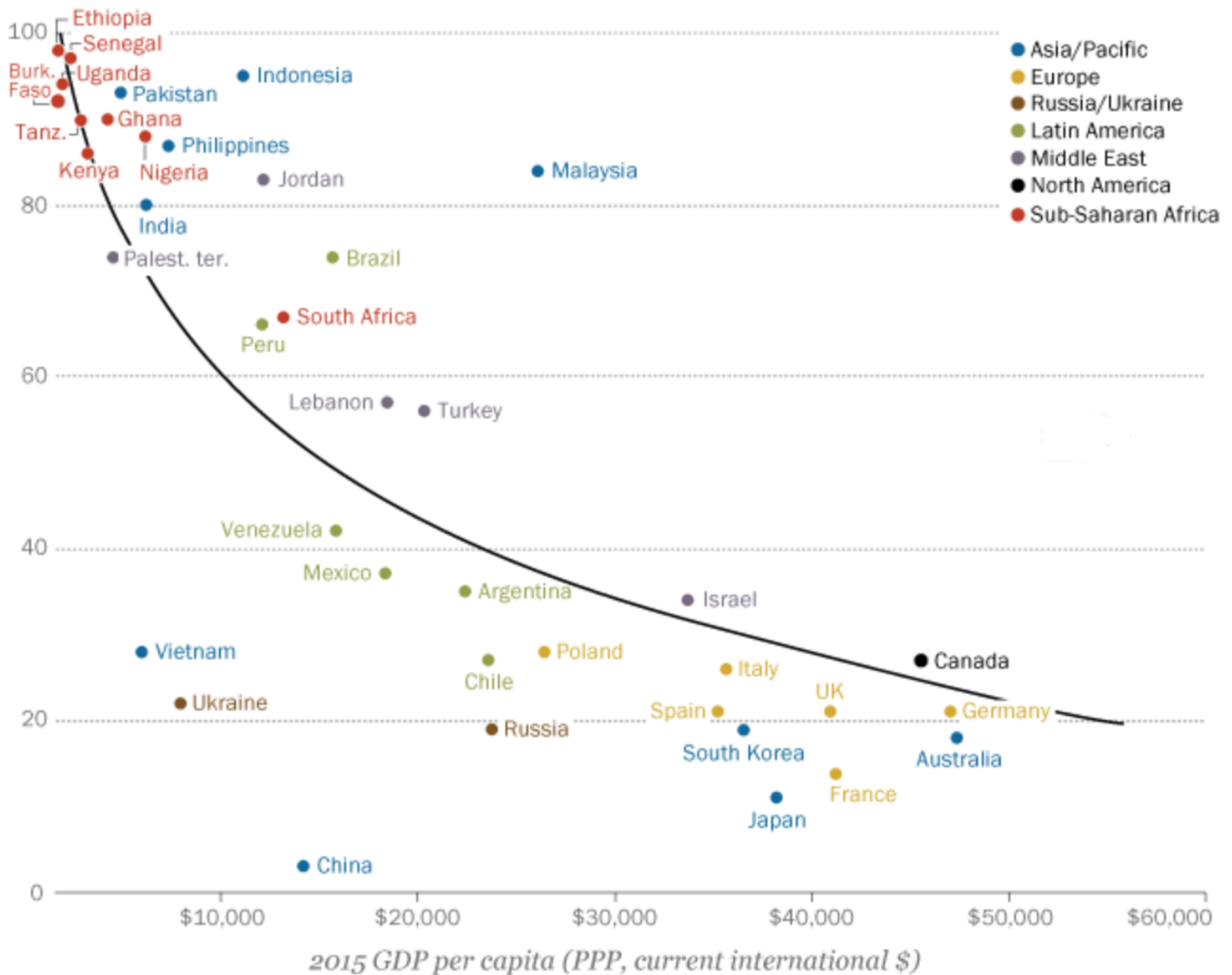


# Generally, poorer nations tend to be religious; wealthy less so, except for U.S.

% who say religion is very important in their lives

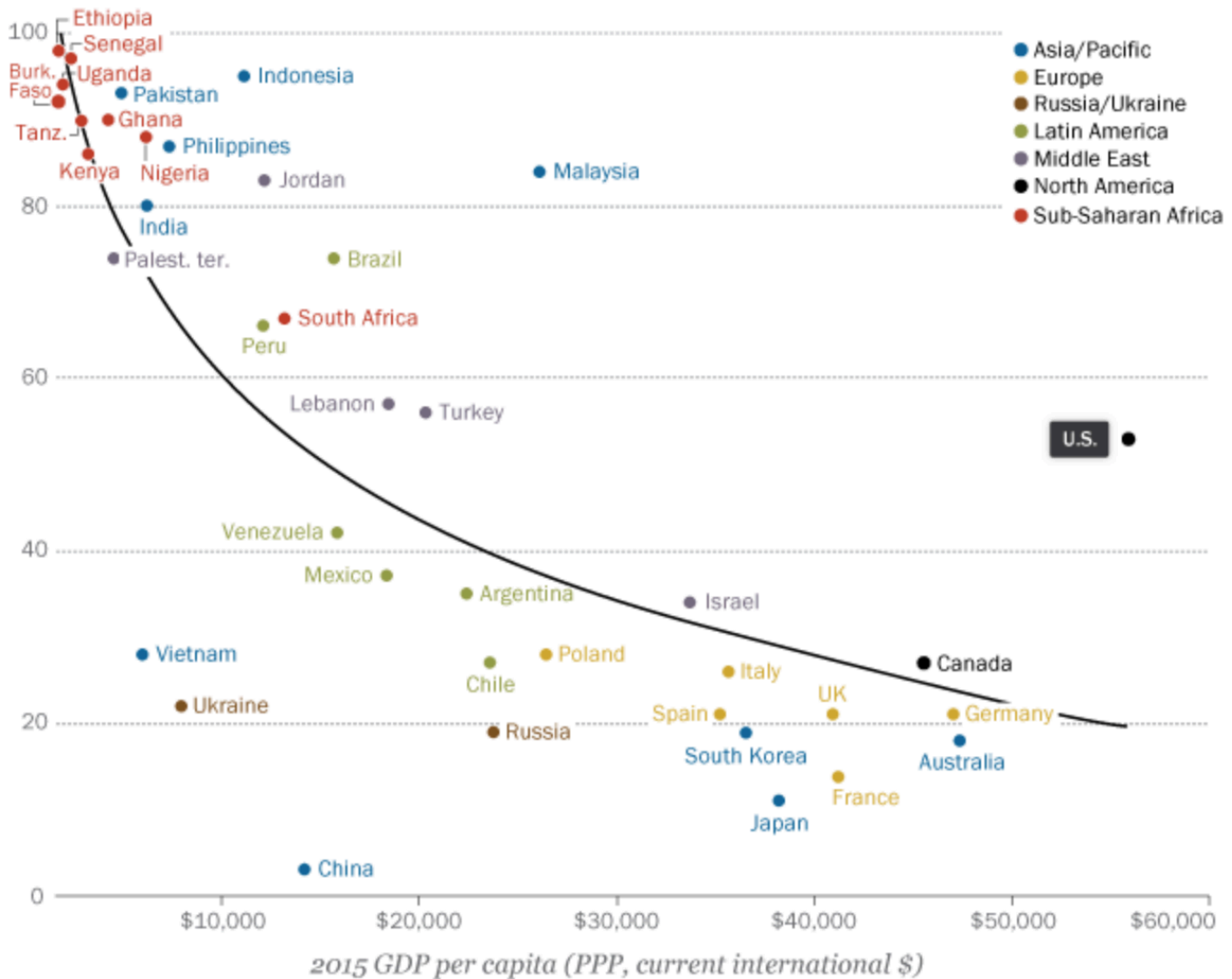
